

Contracting Information Request (CIR)

- + Initiating the CIR
 - By Priority
 - Customer portal
- + Notification and Response
 - Primary Contact
- + Review and Process

ICANN Reviews & Processes



Completing the Registry Agreement

- + Creating the Draft Registry Agreement
 - Based on responses to CIR
 - No changes requested = eligible for execution
 - Changes requested = negotiation
- + Applicant Contracting Point of Contact (POC) reviews Draft Registry Agreement
- + Negotiation and Agreement



Contracting Points of Contact


- + Provide Points of Contact for:
 - Contracting Process Contact
 - Signatory to the Agreement
 - Legal Notices Contact






Registry Agreement – Exhibit A, Approved Services

+ All Additional Services, if any, must be listed in Exhibit A



+ If there are Additional Services, Exhibit A will be developed jointly between ICANN and the Applicant





Registry Agreement - Specification 8, Continued Operations Instrument

- + Continued Operations Instrument (COI)
 - Irrevocable Standby Letter of Credit, or
 - Irrevocable Cash Escrow Deposit
- + COI must meet all requirements of Specification 8, including those regarding:
 - Term
 - Amount
 - Draw
 - Notice/Consent



Changes to Application Data

+ Applicants must submit a change request when information in application becomes untrue or inaccurate



- + All approved change requests must undergo a 30-day comment period
- + Applications may not proceed to the next step until the 30-day period has elapsed
- + Some change requests will require re-evaluation
- + Process to submit a change request is posted on the microsite



Cross-Ownership Relationships

- + Per AGB section 5.1, applicants need to provide a statement of cross-ownership, if applicable

- + Submit with your CIR package
- + ICANN intends to provide a sample statement



Registry Agreement - Specification 9, Code of Conduct Exemption Requests


- + Applicants have the option to request an exemption if:
 - All domains are registered to registry operator for its own exclusive use
 - Registry operator does not sell or transfer use of any registrations to any non-affiliate
 - The application of the Code of Conduct is not necessary to protect the public interest





Special Considerations - IGO/Governments & Community

- + IGO or Governmental Applicants
 - Submit documentation of IGO/Governmental standing



- + Community Applicants
 - Specification 12 must include all Community
 Registration Policies and must match what was listed in the Application
 - Specification 12 will be developed jointly between ICANN and the applicant
- + Applicants that are both IGO/Governmental and Community must provide information outlined in both sections above



Requested Changes to the Registry Agreement

+ Per Module 5 of the AGB, applicants are expected to enter into the Registry Agreement substantially as written



- Applicants may request and negotiate terms by exception
- + Applicants who request to negotiate terms will take substantially longer to complete contracting

NOTE: Draft Registry Agreement, including PIC Specs, is still subject to change pursuant to ICANN consideration of public comments and GAC Advice

Getting Ready for Contracting

- + Access the Contracting Information Request (CIR) guidance to be provided on the microsite
- + Begin document collection for CIR
- + Check COI to make sure it meets requirements
- + Submit a change request for any changes to your Application
- + Watch for posted updates, including CIR request

Get a Head Start on Pre-Delegation Testing

+ Contract with an approved Data Escrow Agent
